Trump Administration Infrastructure Announcement

- MassDOT will work with federal officials & members of Congress to shape this package.
- Meanwhile, MassDOT is going ahead and doing work as though our federal funding will continue at the levels Congress has authorized.
- If revenue sources change, adjustments will be made as needed.

Capital Budget

- MassDOT sources:
 - ANF provided bond cap targets for 2019-2023; annual targets are level with final 2018-2022 plan amounts
- Capital spend for Q2:
 - Capital spend through December 2017 (Q2) on target with second quarter spending in FY 17.


The Commission on the Future of Transportation in the Commonwealth was sworn in by Governor Baker on Thursday, February 8th, 2018
