Improvements include:


- One Stop Shop for requesting HR Services

- Since February 2016, \$33 million total awarded municipalities


Thursday, March 14, Working Group report released



- Not the end of collaborative work 11 agencies will continue to advance solutions to regional transportation challenges resulting from economic development in Everett, Somerville, Cambridge and Boston
- Report findings are consistent with Focus40 and Commission on the Future of Transportation in the Commonwealth findings – the transportation system needs to move more people in fewer vehicles

Berkshire Flyer Subcommittee Report: Pilot Seasonal Rail Service between NYC and Pittsfield

- Subcommittee report filed w/ MA Legislature on March 1st
- Recommendation to begin pilot service in 2020.
- Next steps: identify financing, find a local sponsor, then have MassDOT finalize a contract with Amtrak.
