MassDOT leadership visited the Hyannis Transportation Center, Beach Road shared use path project, Martha's Vineyard Airport, and an RMV Customer Service center

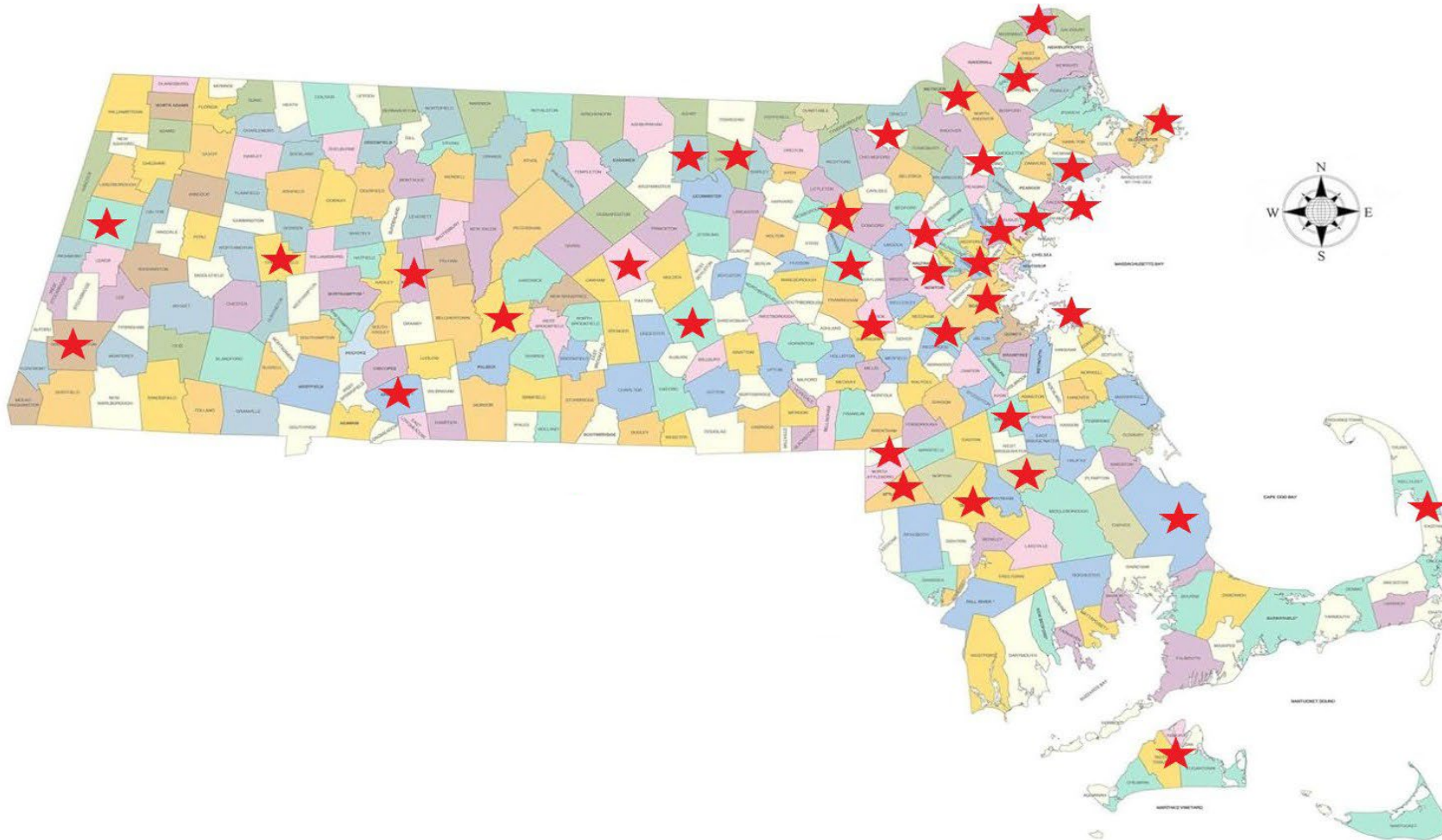

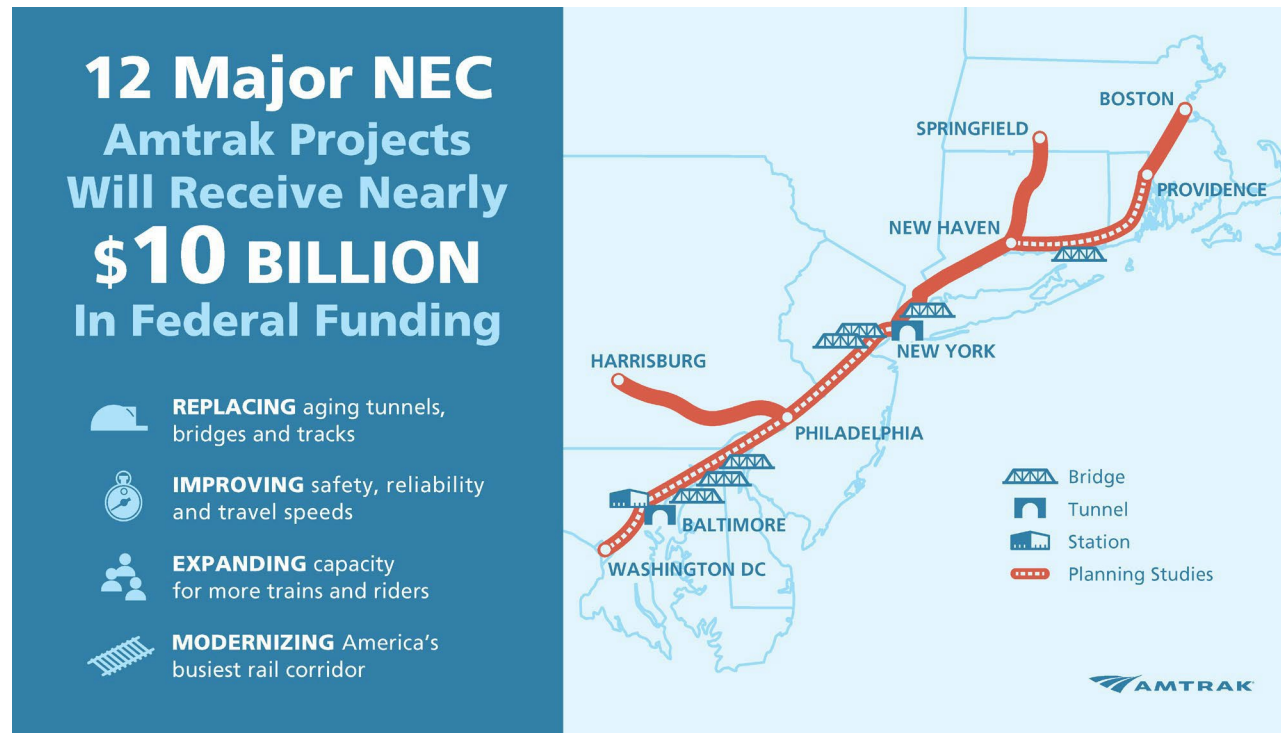
