FY27 Chapter 90 Supplemental Bill

CONTINUED INVESTMENT

- **\$300M** annually for 4 years (\$1.2B authorization)
 - **\$100M** distributed by lane miles
- **\$500M** for MassDOT Lifecycle Asset Management Program
- **\$200M** for MBTA Rail Reliability & Modernization

NEW PROGRAMS

- **\$200M** for Parkway Resilience Improvement and Safety Modernization (PRISM) Program for DCR Assets
- **\$200M** for transportation projects to unlock housing development

REAUTHORIZATION OF 2022 TRANSPORTATION BOND BILL PROGRAMS

- **\$2.3B** in reauthorized federal aid highway spending
- **\$800M** in reauthorized nonfederal aid highway spending
- **\$65M** in reauthorized municipal pavement program spending
- **\$12M** in reauthorized Shared Streets and spaces program spending

Chapter 90 Program

Authorized through Massachusetts General Laws (M.G.L) Chapter 90, Section 34, the Chapter 90 Program provides funding to municipalities for the implementation of capital improvements on local public ways.

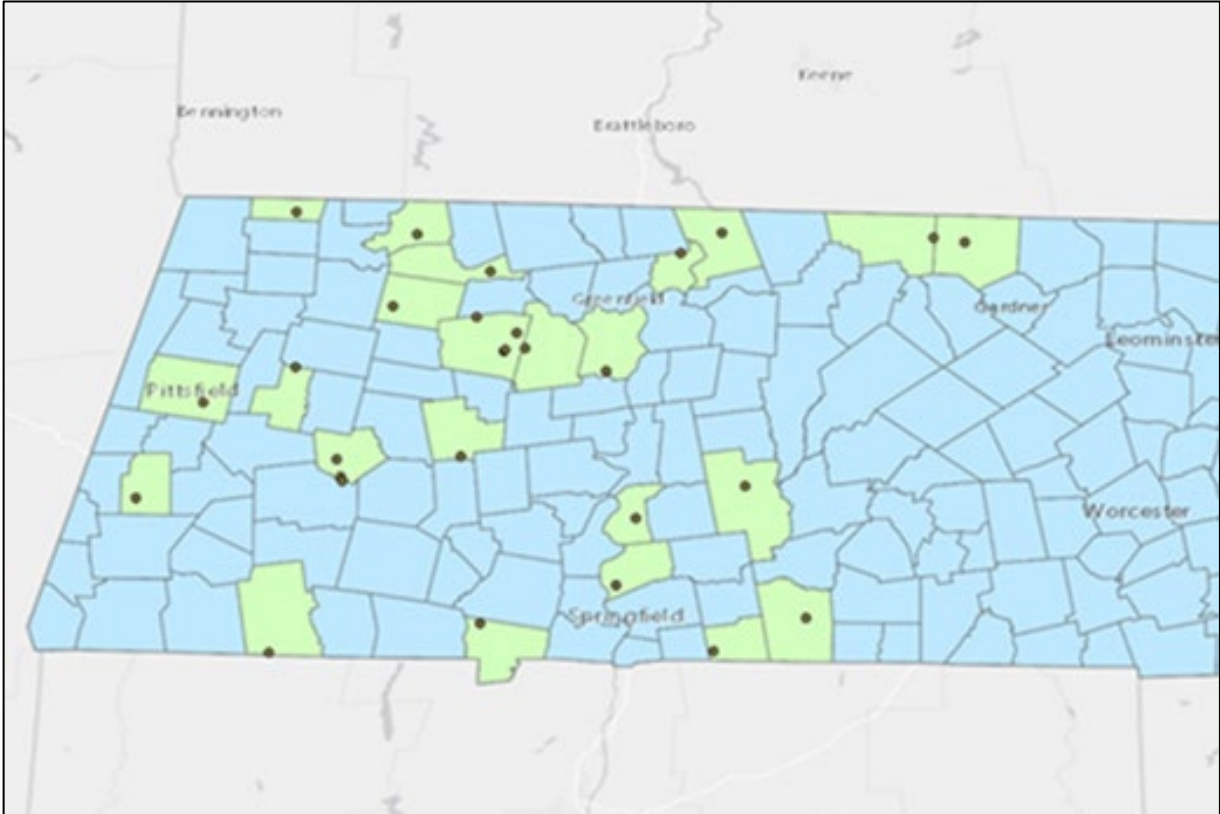

- FY 27 & FY 28
- 34 communities
- 217 miles of roadway

Since 2021

- \$125M to communities
- Over 600 roadway miles

REAL ID/TSA Update

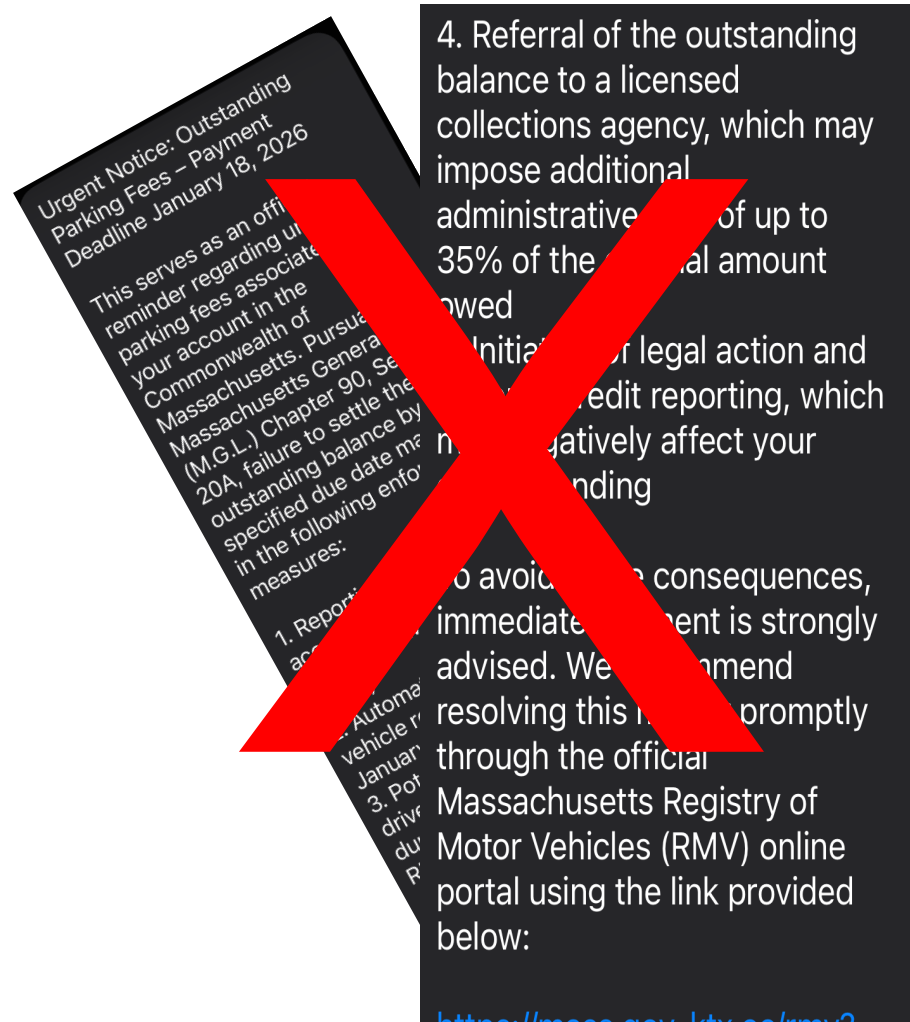


Starting February 1, 2026
