On 5-14-15 I, P.O. Jeff Carlson, held a search warrant for 89 Endicott St. #3(third floor) with Heriberto Rivera dob 8-12-86 being the named target. Sgt. Matt Early reviewed the affidavit and Clerk Barbara O'Brien issued the warrant. Members of the Vice Squad established surveillance of 89 Endicott Street in anticipation of executing the warrant. I observed a male walk off of the front porch who appeared to be Rivera. This male entered the front passenger seat of a Chevrolet Avalanche bearing Ma reg 5XGM80. I radioed my observations and followed the Chevy in an attempt to confirm the front passenger was Rivera. I lost sight of the vehicle on Rt.146 South. I exited onto Providence Street and searched the area for the Chevy.

Sgt. Matt Early observed the same Chevy bearing Ma reg 5XGM80 on Providence Street approx. 15 minutes later. I observed the operator as the Chevy was stopped at Providence at Holcomb. I recognized the operator as Jorge Zambrano dob 3-14-81. I know Zambrano through past arrests and encounters. I also know that Zambrano's license to operate motor vehicles has been revoked for years with no hope of re-instatement for years to come.

Vehicular and pedestrian traffic was very heavy at this time of day, approx. 1400 hrs. We followed the vehicle until we found a suitable area to attempt a stop. P.O.'s Sean Barbale and Mike Spalatro were in full uniform in a fully marked Police Cruiser. They attempted to stop the Chevy on Branch using lights and sirens. The Chevy stopped for a few seconds and then sped away traveling to Orient, through the parking lot of Honey Farms at Billings Square, Grafton, Arthur, Acton, to Massasoit Road where it was determined to terminate the pursuit. The Chevy struck and damaged a Mercedes reg 3KHB10 within the Honey Farms lot and left the scene. P.O. Spalatro stated that Zambrano was operating at speeds far greater than what was reasonable. Zambrano traveled on Arthur Street against the one way. P.O. Sam Rivera stated that Zambrano drove past Rice Square School at approx. 60 m.p.h. while school was letting out with many pedestrians and vehicles in the area. Based on the above I believe that Zambrano was operating recklessly to endanger the public.

Members of the Vice Squad traveled to 89 Endicott and entered the target apartment on the third floor. Catherine Cruz dob 4-24-83 and David Perez dob 2-12-78 were secured within. P.O. James Carmody forced entry into bedroom #3, the room at the far right corner of the apartment as viewed from Endicott Street. Bedroom #3 was the only room that was locked within the apartment. Cruz and Perez were shown the warrant and read Miranda. They both stated that they understand their rights. I asked Catherine where Heriberto was and she said "he was here this morning... I don't know". I asked Catherine where Heriberto stays and she said "he goes between Lakeside and here". I asked where he sleeps within the apartment and she said "right there... the door you broke" as she pointed toward bedroom #3. I asked Catherine why the door was locked and she stated that Heriberto doesn't like her going into his room and cleaning all of the time because she has OCD.

The following items were recovered from bedroom #3 identified as Heriberto Rivera's; scale, identifications in the name of Heriberto Rivera, bag of suspected cocaine, .357 caliber firearm loaded with ammunition, paperwork in the name of Heriberto Rivera, crib notes, a cell phone, two knotted bags of suspected cocaine, a zip lock bag of suspected cocaine, packaging materials, photographs of Rivera, and other items that will be detailed in supplemental reports. C.S.U. Sgt. Eric Boss recovered the firearm. All other evidence was placed into the Vice Squad evidence bin, the suspected cocaine will be analyzed. Some items were turned over to the Crimes Scene Unit for fingerprint analysis.

The Chevy was found abandoned on Sunderland Road. Officers searched the area using a P.O. Dan Daly and his K-9 partner from Millbury. P.O. Daly and his K-9 partner found what appears to be illegal drugs in a pipe. The suspected drugs were recovered and will be submitted for fingerprint analysis. The Chevy was towed to Police Headquarters. There was an incident that occurred during the transport of the Chevy reference I#201545661.

Based on my experiences, I believe that Heriberto Rivera possessed the cocaine within bedroom #3 with the intent to distribute. I also believe that based on the evidence Rivera possessed the firearm and ammunition.

I am requesting a warrant issue for Heriberto Rivera dob 8-12-86 charging; possession of a firearm without a FID, possession of ammunition without a FID, and possession class B with the intent to distribute.

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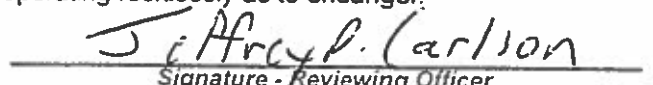
