# SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to participate in WIA Title I services, certain Selective Service requirements must be met by One-Stop Career Center customers:

- (A) All males born in the United States on or after January 1, 1960 *must have registered* with the Selective Service System (must be able to document registration with SSS).
- (B) Males not born in the United States, whose birth date is on or after January 1, 1960 and who entered the U.S. before their 26<sup>th</sup> birthday *must have registered* with the Selective Service System (must be able to document their date of entry and date of birth). Since a foreign born male who enters the U.S. as a student attending school on a full-time basis is not required to register with Selective Service, verification of the individual's F1 Student Visa status when he was between the ages of 18-26 would be sufficient.
- (C) Males not born in the United States, whose birth date is on or after January 1, 1960 and who entered the U.S. after their 26<sup>th</sup> birthday are not required to register with Selective Service (must document their date of entry and date of birth).
- (D) Males born on or after January 1, 1960 and who have been discharged from U.S. military service must document their date of discharge on their DD214

For non-U.S. born customers presentation of either a Certificate of Naturalization form or a valid United States Passport will indicate that an individual has met all Selective Service requirements, as Selective Service compliance is also a requirement of the naturalization process.
