Purpose: To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators

and other local workforce investment partners of the revised Federal poverty guidelines for the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) as set through the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) Training and

Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) 11-13, dated February 5, 2014.

Background: The Department of Health and Human Services published the updated Federal

poverty guidelines for 2014 on January 22, 2014. These guidelines provide the basis for determining the income eligibility of SCSEP applicants and enrollees after being multiplied by 125 percent to convert the poverty guidelines to "low-income" as defined at Section 518(a)(3)(A) of the 2006 Amendments to the Older

Americans Act (OAA).

Action

Required: Grantees must use the poverty and low-income guidelines when determining or

recertifying SCSEP participant eligibility (<u>TEGL</u>) <u>11-13</u>. The 2014 rate reflects 1.5 percent increase to account for last year's price increase as measured by the

Consumer Price Index.
