

Hear from people & their families on proposed changes and ways to improve them



When	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Throughout 2026 at key points in project (e.g., after levels are developed)
Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speak directly to people about what we have heard needs fixing about services• Discuss where we are in the project• Share ideas for proposed changes• Collect ideas to use in decisions
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 12 to 16 sessions with people & their families (less than 10 people per session)• Engage in conversation to learn & give feedback



Benchmark Presentations

Create an open forum for spreading information on the project and collecting feedback

When	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Throughout 2026 at key points in project (e.g., after levels are developed)
Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Allow for people statewide to hear from HSRI & DDS what is going on with the project & what will change
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 4 to 6 recorded Zoom meetings• Share information on the status of the project• Collect questions and feedback• Share contact information for follow up


