

MINUTES

September 30, 2024

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on September 30, 2024. In participation was: Supt. Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Supt. Bart Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioner Jim Quirk.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:

Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through 3/31/25, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 29, 2023.

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the minutes of August 26, 2024. Vice-Chairman Collins 2nd the motion and it was approved unanimously by way of roll call.

Regarding the office lease status, Supt. Sakolsky informed that we heard late in the day Friday that all lease documents have been signed and we will be moving this week to the new location.


Heavy rains coincided with high tides creating greater salt water mosquito habitat this month, so crews are still treating larvae and DPH is still conducting arbovirus testing.

As of today, Barnstable County has had 3 positive EEE mosquito samples and 10 positive WNV mosquito samples. We received report of one human case in Barnstable County.

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to authorize a 2% FY25 COLA increase, effective November 4, 2024. Motion 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll-call.

The next meeting was scheduled for October 21, 2024 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Chairman Milne and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
