



## Precipitation & Departures

Accumulated Precipitation (inches) August 1, 2025 - August 31, 2025







- 2-3" inch totals north of I-90
- 3-5" along and south of I-90 in central MA
- I-3" over southeast MA and Cape/Islands

#### Departure from Normal

Precipitation Departure from Normal (inches) August 1, 2025 - August 31, 2025





Generally I to 2 inches below normal Small swath of 0-I inch above normal in central MA


## 3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



#### Last 3 Months (June-August)

- Below normal since June 1st
- Generally 40-80% of climatological normal
- Nantucket < 40% of normal</li>


Precipitation Percent of Normal June 1, 2025 - August 31, 2025







Near Normal since March 1st

Precipitation Percent of Normal March 1, 2025 - August 31, 2025











- ~10 predict 10 Day QPF > 1-2"







## Outlook: September 12<sup>th</sup> -16th



#### Odds favor near to below normal precipitation and below normal temperatures






## Outlook: August 16<sup>th</sup>-August 29<sup>th</sup>



#### Equal Chances for Above or Below Normal Precip


#### Leaning Above Normal Temperatures




## Outlook for Sep, Oct, Nov

#### Above Normal Temperatures Likely







## Boston/Norton MA WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

No river flooding anticipated during the next ten days.

- A 52 member ensemble run for all NERFC forecast points to give us an idea of the possible range of river flows out 10 days.
- No Flooding Forecast





#### August:

- Departures generally I-2 inches below normal
- Below Normal Precipitation for most of Massachusetts
- Pockets of near to above normal precipitation in central MA

#### Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month deficits for most of state (40-80% of normal)
- 6-month precipitation is near-normal
- Sections of Cape and Islands still below normal (40-60% of normal)

#### Outlook:

- 7 Day Outlook is very dry with a chance for precipitation over southeast MA/Cape on Wednesday
- No strong signal for above or below normal precipitation in the long range forecast (beyond 10 days)
