


August Precipitation




Accumulated Precipitation (in)


3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal

Accumulated Precipitation (in): Percent of 1991-2020 Normals


June 01, 2024 to August 31, 2024





Temperature Departures




Average Temperature (°F): Departure from 1991-2020 Normals

August 01, 2024 to August 31, 2024




Average Temperature (°F): Departure from 1991-2020 Normals

Highlights:


- Dry through early next week

- No rainfall expected elsewhere


Outlook: Sat Sep 14 - Wed Sep 18

Odds favor below average rainfall and above average temperatures







Outlook: Mon Sep 16 - Sun Sep 22

Odds favor average rainfall and above average temperatures





Odds favor near to perhaps below normal precipitation





Outlook: October, November, December





- August rainfall was near normal with the following exceptions:
 - Above normal in western and northern MA
 - Below to much below normal on Cape Cod, Nantucket, and near Edgartown
- Three-month departures have shown a decline in eastern MA
- Six-month departures are on the lower end of normal on Cape Cod and Nantucket
- So far in September, rainfall has been minimal and is well below average
- Dry weather pattern continues for at least the next two weeks
 - Perhaps up to 1/4 inch of rainfall through next Monday, mainly in western MA
- Above normal temperatures should continue through the fall
- May see a somewhat wetter pattern emerge later in the fall (October/November)
 - o In the meantime, we still need to watch the tropics!
