Targeted Monitoring	MT, ID, MA (fish toxics, reference site network, 319 project effectiveness)
Rotational Monitoring	MN, NV, NM, NY, OH, OK, RI, UT, WY, ME, VA, MA (rotating 5 yr)
USE OF DATA FROM OTHER SOURCES	AZ, CA, Al, CO, FL, IL, MD, MI, MN, MT, NH, KS, NY, TX, UT, VA, VT, <b>MA</b>
Use of improved tools and databases	MT, NM, NY, TX, MA (EQuIS)
