Piccolino's Inc. ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, August 20, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Di Cicco & Keefe's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. On Monday, May 20, 2024, at approximately 8:11 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Keefe ("Investigators"), conducted a compliance check at Piccolino's Inc.
2. An underage operative working under the supervision of Investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, one bottle of Bud Light beer, for four dollars and seventy-five cents (\$4.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license for more than ten years with no previous violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
