DECISION

Shree Bhagvati, Inc. dba Roux's Market (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, December 6, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report dated August 15, 2011.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On, August 15, 2011 at approximately 5:55 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Shree Bhagvati, Inc. dba Roux's Market.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Budweiser twenty-four (24) ounce can for two dollars and twenty-four cents (\$2.24). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

 Administrative review indicates no prior violations and licensee has had the license since 2006.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
