## DECISION

Ramandeep, Inc. dba Bollywood Grill (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 10, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Doyle's Report.

## FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, June 12, 2013, at approximately 5:50 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Ramandeep, Inc. dba Bollywood Grill.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer, for four dollars and thirty cents (\$4.30). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

As the licensee has been in business for sixteen (16) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
