I.	Terms & Conditions	
a.	The loan period shall begin on <b>Date</b> at <b>Time</b> and shall end on <b>Date</b> at <b>Time</b> .

The Department of the ervices will arrange for delivery and return of the unit by a qualified DFS staff member.	
repair	shall be responsible for any damages, loss or theft of the Equipment. lamages, loss or theft must be reported to FSD immediately upon discovery. The cost of and/or replacement of items damaged, lost or stolen while in the custody of the City/the will be invoiced and payable immediately to FSD at the conclusion of the loan period.	
in	The Equipment shall be used only by DFS employees and officials of the fire department Use of Equipment by third parties, outside vendors or private contractors etly forbidden.	

e. There must be a department staff member who has been qualified by FSD as an instructor. This individual, once approved by the Director of FSD, shall be responsible and present at all times for conducting the session where the Equipment is in use.

## II. <u>Integration Clause</u>

a. This agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements, oral or written. No amendment to this agreement shall be effective unless signed by both parties and no assignment shall be permitted unless consulted to by FSD.

## III. Agency Liability

a. FSD shall use reasonable good faith efforts to fulfill its obligations under this agreement but shall not be liable for any actions taken or omitted in connection with this agreement.

IV. <u>Indemnity Clause</u>
