Division of Insurance v. Qiunan Chang

ORDER

On July 1, 2024, the Division of Insurance (“Division”) filed an Order to Show Cause against Respondent Qiunan Chang (“Respondent”). On July 26, 2024, the Parties filed a fully executed Consent Agreement in which Respondent assented to the revocation of his non-resident Massachusetts insurance producer license. Accordingly, after consideration of the record, it is

ORDERED: that any and all insurance producer licenses issued by the Division to Respondent are hereby revoked; and it is

Further Ordered: that Respondent shall return to the Division any licenses in his possession, custody or control; and it is

Further Ordered: that from the date of this Order Respondent is prohibited from soliciting, aiding in the placement, continuation or negotiation of insurance policies or taking any action which may lead any person or entity to believe that Respondent is authorized in the Commonwealth to engage in the business of insurance in any capacity; and it is

Further Ordered:

that within (30) days from the date of this Order Respondent shall dispose of any and all interests (direct and indirect) he may have as proprietor, partner,

stockholder, officer or employee of any licensed insurance company in
Massachusetts.
