Dear Mr. Lenane:

I represent the Massachusetts Division of Insurance (“Division”) with regard to the above referenced investigation. Pursuant to an investigation conducted by the Division’s Special Investigations Unit, the Division has cause to believe that you have violated the Massachusetts insurance law described by the conduct detailed below.

According to Division licensing records, your public insurance adjuster license expired for nonrenewal on or about March 6, 2023, and was not renewed until on or about September 12, 2023. On September 18, 2023, you responded via email to the Division and wrote that you conducted 4 appraisals during the unlicensed period that generated \$5,154.48 in commissions.

The Division alleges that you committed at least 4 violations of M.G.L. c. 175, § 172 by conducting business within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts while unlicensed as a public insurance adjuster. The penalty for each violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 172 is a fine of not more than \$10,000.00.

The Division proposes to resolve this matter through a settlement if you agree to waive the right to a public hearing, agree to cease and desist from the above-alleged conduct and **agree to pay a fine of \$1,000**. If you accept the Division’s settlement offer in this letter, please sign this settlement letter where provided below and return it to my attention along with a check made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, no later than **March 1, 2024**.

The Division considers the acceptance of this settlement agreement to constitute a reportable administrative event which must be included on your next Massachusetts public insurance adjuster license renewal application. You also may be required to report this action in other jurisdictions where you hold a public insurance adjuster license. This settlement agreement shall be construed under and governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Although this correspondence does not constitute the required statutory notice of a public hearing, if this matter is not resolved by **March 1, 2024**, the Division intends to file its Order to Show Cause and will notify you of the hearing date.
