**AMENDED SPECIAL MASTER'S WEEKLY REPORT\***

Pursuant to the Supreme Judicial Court's April 3, 2020 Opinion and Order in this matter, as amended on April 10, April 28 and June 23, 2020 (the "Order"), the attached Appendix contains the Special Master's weekly report for the period ending June 28, 2020.

The Appendix contains charts reflecting the following information for each of the correctional facilities administered by the Department of Correction and each of the county Sheriffs' offices: (i) overall inmate population; (ii) the number of COVID-19 tests administered by the correctional facilities for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; (iii) the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; and (iv) the number of inmates released pursuant to the procedures or guidance set forth in the Order since April 3, 2020. Figures presented in red in the attached Appendix reflect certain changes, corrections, and amendments made from the daily reporting received by the Special Master and the Special Master's prior weekly report as a result of communications with the parties to this matter. As of June 28, 2,174 inmates have been released from state and county correctional facilities.
