The Appendix contains charts reflecting the following information for each of the correctional facilities administered by the Department of Correction and each of the county Sheriffs' offices: (i) overall inmate population; (ii) the number of COVID-19 tests administered by the correctional facilities for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; (iii) the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; and (iv) the number of inmates released pursuant to the procedures or guidance set forth in the Order since April 3, 2020. Any figures presented in red in the attached Appendix reflect amendments or corrections to figures in a prior Special Master's Weekly Report.

As of September 30, 3,564 inmates have been released from state and county correctional facilities.
