SPECIAL MASTER'S WEEKLY REPORT

Pursuant to the Supreme Judicial Court's April 3, 2020 Opinion and Order in this matter, as amended on April 10, April 28 and June 23, 2020 (the "Order"), the attached Appendix contains the Special Master's weekly report for the period ending July 15, 2020.

The Appendix contains charts reflecting the following information for each of the correctional facilities administered by the Department of Correction and each of the county Sheriffs' offices: (i) overall inmate population; (ii) the number of COVID-19 tests administered by the correctional facilities for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; (iii) the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; and (iv) the number of inmates released pursuant to the procedures or guidance set forth in the Order since April 3, 2020.

Any figures presented in red in the attached Appendix reflect amendments or corrections to figures in a prior Special Master's Weekly Report. Since the changes in reporting pursuant to the Court's June 23 Order, the Special Master has identified possible discrepancies in the cumulative figures reported by the County Jails and Houses of Correction for the number of COVID-19 tests administered and the number of COVID-19 positive tests. The Special Master is working with the County Sheriffs to reconcile these figures and will identify any amended figures in a future weekly report.

As of July 15, 2,446 inmates have been released from state and county correctional facilities.
