#### SPECIAL MASTER'S WEEKLY REPORT

Pursuant to the Supreme Judicial Court's April 3, 2020 Opinion and Order in this matter, as amended on April 10, April 28 and June 23, 2020 (the "Order"), the attached Appendix contains the Special Master's weekly report for the period ending July 2, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

The Appendix contains charts reflecting the following information for each of the correctional facilities administered by the Department of Correction and each of the county Sheriffs' offices: (i) overall inmate population; (ii) the number of COVID-19 tests administered by the correctional facilities for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; (iii) the number of confirmed positive COVID-19 cases for all inmates, correctional officers, or other staff members, including contractors; and (iv) the number of inmates released pursuant to the procedures or guidance set forth in the Order since April 3, 2020. As of July 2, 2,271 inmates have been released from state and county correctional facilities.
