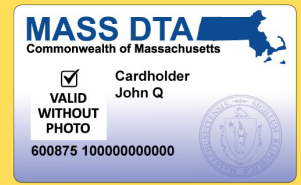


Buying Food Online with SNAP

Fact Sheet



Starting May 29, 2020, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) EBT can be used to buy food online from Amazon and Walmart.

Where can I buy food online using SNAP?

Amazon and Walmart. More retailers may be added later.

What can I buy online at Amazon and Walmart?

You can buy SNAP eligible foods.

Can I use my SNAP benefits to pay the delivery fee?

No. You must pay for fees with another form of payment, like a credit card or gift card.

I receive TAFDC or EAEDC benefits. Can I use my cash benefits to buy items online?

No. You cannot use your cash benefits on an EBT card to buy online. If you have a bank account you can ask your case manager to sign up for direct deposit so your benefits go directly into your bank account.



Is there a delivery fee?	Fees vary \$7.95-\$9.95 Option to pay a flat fee of \$98 per year for all fees	Free if you spend \$35 or more
How do I get the food?	Curbside pickup OR delivery at some locations Go to Walmart.com and type in your zip code for options near you	Delivery only
How do I know what to buy?	At checkout, the payment screen will show what is SNAP eligible	Look for 'SNAP EBT Eligible' label next to the item's name
