

# APPLY to join the SNAP Restaurant Meals Program

Restaurants and food trucks can apply to participate in the pilot now through October 31, 2022



## What is the Restaurant Meals Program (RMP)?

The RMP will allow older adults (60+), homeless individuals, and people with disabilities to buy food at authorized restaurants/food trucks using their SNAP EBT card. The program supports populations that may encounter barriers and challenges with buying and storing groceries, as well as cooking and preparing meals for themselves.



## Who can apply?

Any restaurant or food truck can apply for the pilot if they are:

- Locally- and privately-owned;
- Not part of a restaurant conglomerate or multi-unit chain (including franchises); and
- Provide counter-based service and payment.



Businesses will be evaluated on a multitude of criteria, including their ability to service SNAP clients with disabilities and their commitment and ties to their local communities.
