Landfill Post-Closure Care

- Will extend beyond initial 30 year post-closure period
- Need to establish framework for post 30 year requirements – either via policy or regulation
- MassDEP will not approve reductions of financial assurance mechanism (FAM) below 50% of original amount (pending further policy development)

PFAS Sampling & Response @ Landfills

- Developing approach for establishing PFAS sampling & response requirements
- Have already begun at some landfills where existing concerns with PFAS contamination
- Will have more information on planned approach shortly

Waste Management Capacity Needs

- Recognize in-state and regional capacity shortfalls
- Solid Waste Master Plan approach to maximize diversion to minimize capacity need
- MassDEP also open to permitting other in-state management capacity

Next Steps

- Plan to advance regulation revisions in Spring 2023
- Priority discussion topics will be those that may require regulation changes
 - Landfill post closure care
 - Soils management at solid waste facilities
