DECISION

The Wine Cask, Inc. ("the licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on August 3, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

<u>Facts</u>

- 1. On, June 2, 2010 at approximately 6:38 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation The Wine Cask, Inc.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a six (6) pack of cans of Bud Light for \$6.50. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file shows that the licensee has been in business since 1983 and has had no prior violation

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. As the licensee has had no previous violations the Commission **issues a warning.**
