D/B/A WHITE WING LIQUOR GAS AND CONVENIENCE

Aaryna Inc. d/b/a White Wing Liquor Gas and Convenience (“Licensee” or “White Wing”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator McDonough’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Violation Report of D. McDonough;
2. ABCC Form 43, Transfer of License Approval, 3/10/2014;
3. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Friday, April 4, 2025, at approximately 7:10 p.m., Investigators Velez and McDonough (“Investigators”) conducted surveillance of the business operation of Aaryna Inc. d/b/a White Wing Liquor Gas and Convenience (“Licensee” or “White Wing”).
2. Investigators observed a youthful appearing male individual exit the licensed premises in possession of alcoholic beverages. Investigators approached the youthful appearing male individual, identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.
3. Underage #1, actual date of birth 5/05/2005 (age 19), was in possession of one 12-pack of Bud Light beer. He stated to Investigators that he was not asked for any identification when he purchased the beer.
4. Investigators entered the licensed premises at approximately 7:15 p.m. and informed the clerk of the violation and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.


5. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2014 with no previous violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 Count). As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
