**DECISION**

**LIANGFENG INC. DBA ROSE GARDEN**  
**1 SOUTHVILLE RD.**  
**SOUTHBOROUGH, MA 01772**

Liangfeng Inc. dba Rose Garden (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 14, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report dated June 19, 2013.

A. Licensee's New Protocol to Employees for Serving Alcoholic Beverages.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On Wednesday, June 19, 2013, at approximately 6:44 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Liangfeng Inc. dba Rose Garden.
2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer for three dollars and twenty cents (\$3.20). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


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### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


