**DECISION**

**JAY PANCHAM INC. D/B/A JIM'S LIQUOR  
916 MAIN STREET

Jay Pancham Inc. d/b/a Jim's Liquor ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. ABCC Form 43, Transfer of License Approval, 9/26/2006;
3. ABCC Decision, 11/5/2019;
4. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Tuesday, May 31, 2022, at approximately 8:30 p.m., Investigators Fleming and Keefe ("Investigators") inspected the business operation of Jay Pancham Inc. d/b/a Jim's Liquor.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a 24-ounce can of Bud Light beer for three dollars and twenty-six cents (\$3.26). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

### CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
