**DECISION**

**D.V.K.K. INC. D/B/A THE OAK 'N' KEG  
20-24 POINT GROVE RD.  
SOUTHWICK, MA 01077

D.V.K.K. Inc. d/b/a The Oak 'N' Keg (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 8, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Temple's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Temple's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
3. Copy of License Transfer Application Approved 3/3/2008.

**FACTS**


1. On Sunday, April 28, 2019, at approximately 4:31 p.m., Investigators Watson and Temple ("Investigators") investigated the business of D.V.K.K. Inc. d/b/a The Oak 'N' Keg.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Light beer for two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2008 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
