**DECISION**

**ILMU, INC. D/B/A ZANTO RESTAURANT**  
**587 COLLEGE HIGHWAY**

ILMU, Inc. d/b/a Zanto Restaurant ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Guarino & Fleming's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigators Guarino & Fleming's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report, 3/6/2024;
2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License;
3. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Wednesday, March 4, 2024, at approximately 5:34 p.m., Special Investigators Guarino and Fleming ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at ILMU, Inc. d/b/a Zanto Restaurant.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one Coors Light draft beer, for five dollars (\$5.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee holds a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12, with no prior violations.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
