DECISION

V.F. Roma Italian Cuisine Inc. dba Roma Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 27, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
- 2. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated January 15, 2014; and
- 3. Picture of Underage Operative.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, January 15, 2014 at approximately 6:07 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of V.F. Roma Italian Cuisine Inc. dba Roma Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased a bottle of Budweiser Light beer for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for over ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
