**DECISION**

**GOS, LLC dba First-N-10**

GOS, LLC dba First-N-10 ("Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, April 19, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.16 (1) detailed in Investigator Michael Teehan's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Michael Teehan's Report dated January 6, 2011.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On Friday December 3, 2010, Commission Investigators and the Springfield State Police entered the licensed premises to conduct a city wide enhanced enforcement operation relative to the service to intoxicated patrons.
2. Upon entry the investigators identified themselves and observed there was a cover charge for admission into the licensed premises.
3. The investigators also observed the licensee failed to post a cover charge outside the licensed premises and did not provide a numbered printed receipt.
4. Investigator Michael Teehan testified the licensee had spoken to him on the phone and stipulated to the violation as described in his report (Exhibit 1).
5. Administrative review of the file indicates this was the first violation by the licensee.

**CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.16 (1) and therefore issues a **WARNING**.
