DECISION

LIMELIGHT ROOM, INC. DBA LIMELIGHT
357 COTTAGE STREET

Limelight Room, Inc. dba Limelight (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 10, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138 §34c (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski's report.

FACTS


1. On Friday, September 30, 2011 at approximately 11:200 p.m., Investigators Kenny, Teehan and Kujawski investigated the business operation of Limelight Room, Inc. dba Limelight.
2. The investigators entered the premises and observed a youthful looking female patron in possession of an alcoholic beverage, later identified as a vodka and Red Bull.
3. The investigators identified themselves and asked for her identification.
4. Investigator Kujawski asked the youthful female patron if the licensee asked her for identification.
5. She stated that she was not asked for identification.
6. The investigators spoke with the bartender on duty, Christine Moriarty, informed her of the violation and advised her that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further action.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34c. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
