- **1. Call to Order:** Commissioner Lebeaux called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.
- 2. Discussion of Central Massachusetts Mosquito Control providing Mutual Aid to the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (Vote Required) The Board considered approval of the Central Massachusetts Mosquito Control Project providing mutual aid services to the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project. Both Projects are in favor of providing spray assistance in the town of Falmouth as a result of EEEv positive mosquito pools. DPH agrees this is an appropriate action but up to the Projects and local decision. Cape has discussed with the town and they received unanimous support from the Board of Selectman and Board of Health voted for an EEEv health hazard. The Cape has provided notice, will continue outreach to ensure public is aware of limited area spraying. Scheduled to take place over one (1) night using Central staff, equipment, and product. An ISA has been drafted so the Cape will assume to the costs and provide payment to Central for cost of mutual aid. Action Taken: Damon Guterman made a motion to approve the mutual aid and authorize the chair to sign any documents needed to move forward. The motion was seconded by Anne Carroll and the mutual aid is voted for unanimous approval.
- **3. Aerial Spray Update:** Commissioner Lebeaux provided the SRB with an update on the aerial spray activities to date.
