In Memory of Nikki Tishler



Nikki was raised in Easton and most recently lived in Quincy. Her work at MassDOT focused on issues of inclusion and social equity in the transportation planning process, and much of her time was spent on strengthening our implementation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Nikki was also the Coordinator of MassDOT's Safe Routes to School Program and a liaison to three of the Commonwealth's Metropolitan Planning Organizations. Through these connections, Nikki helped to strengthen the local and regional partnerships that are so central to MassDOT's work.

Nikki had recently been recognized for her work by the Boston chapter of the Women in Transportation Seminar, which had selected her to be a 2018 Emerging Professional.

Nikki brought the same passion to her life and work outside of the office as she did to her responsibilities at MassDOT. She was a fierce advocate for social justice; a good and loyal friend; a volunteer for a suicide prevention hotline; a warm and thoughtful person; a lover of candy, yoga, adventurous travel, and dancing; and an observer of her Jewish faith. As one of her colleagues described her, 'Nikki had the innate ability to promote social wellness, which she was a living example of. Her closest colleagues benefited both professionally and personally from her contagious positivity.'
