served with all documents pursuant to 760 CMR 56.06(6)(b) as if such motion or request had

been granted. Proposed interveners shall also be entitled to participate in hearing sessions and

teleconferences. Such persons do not have full rights of parties, and thus, their consent is not

required for assented-to motions pursuant to 760 CMR 56.06(5)(a)(2)(b), joint motions,

stipulations, or similar matters.
