

## MassDOT Community Transit Grant Program FY23 Vehicle Awards

Through the Community Transit Grant Program, MassDOT provides wheelchair-accessible vehicles to Regional Transit Authorities, municipalities, Councils on Aging, and non-profit organizations to expand mobility for older adults and people with disabilities across the Commonwealth. In the FY23 cycle, MassDOT is awarding 133 vehicles for a total value of \$15,336,758.

These awards include 13 fully accessible electric vehicles. This marks the first time MassDOT has been able to offer electric vehicles through the Community Transit Grant Program.

In addition to wheelchair-accessible vehicles, MassDOT also offers grants for operating and mobility management initiatives to expand mobility for older adults and people with disabilities through the Community Transit Grant Program. The FY23 operating and mobility management awards were announced in December 2022.
