Steps for IID Removal

Follow the steps below for removal of an Ignition Interlock Device (IID):

Step 1: Visit any RMV Service Center that conducts Suspension Hearings. Complete a Hearing Sheet. Indicate “Removal” on the Hearing Sheet. The Ignition Interlock Department will contact you via telephone to conduct the Removal Hearing.

- If you have any records or receipts (vendor, mechanical or otherwise) related to **infractions** or **violations** that occurred within the last **6 months** that you would like the Hearing Officer to consider, you may include these records with your Removal Hearing Sheet. Including these records may expedite your Removal Hearing.

Step 2: During the telephone hearing, the Ignition Interlock Department will review whether any infractions or violations occurred in the past **6 months**.

- If the Hearing Officer finds actionable infractions or violations within the last 6 months, your Ignition Interlock Device Removal request will be denied. You will be required to participate in the IID program for an additional **6 months** from the date of your **last** infraction or violation.
- If you do not have any infractions or violations, your Ignition Interlock Device will be approved for removal. The Hearing Officer will remove the Interlock restriction (T) from your license.

Step 3: It is necessary that you obtain an unrestricted replacement Drivers License. Access your myRMV account via Mass.gov/MyRMV. Select the “Replace My Driver’s License” Transaction. You may also call the RMV at (857) 368-8000 for assistance in obtaining a replacement.

Step 4: Once you have completed the unrestricted replacement Drivers License process, contact your Ignition Interlock Device vendor/service provider to have the device removed.
