TO: Retail Sterile and Complex Non-Sterile Compounding Pharmacies in Massachusetts

SUBJECT: Sterile and Complex Non-Sterile Compounding Licensure

In accordance with Massachusetts law, all retail sterile and [complex non-sterile](#) compounding pharmacies located in Massachusetts must obtain an additional license(s) from the Board in order to compound and dispense any sterile or complex non-sterile compounded preparations. M.G.L. c. 112, § 39G and H.

Regulations implementing the requirement for this licensure will promulgated in December, 2024, and on **January 1, 2025**, the Board will begin accepting [applications](#).

In order to comply with the new licensing regulations, a grace period has been established through **March 31, 2025** to apply for the required license(s).

Beginning May 1, 2025, any compounding pharmacy must hold a license(s) in order to continue to dispense compounded prescription products.
