## DECISION

BARBER'S CROSSING NORTH INCORPORATED 175 LEOMINSTER ROAD STERLING, MA 01564 LICENSE#: 123400015 HEARD: 3/6/2012

Barber's Crossing North Incorporated (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, March 6, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Compliance Check Field Report.

- 1. Compliance Check Field Report dated September 24, 2011; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
- A. Letter from Sterling Chief of Police dated May 29, 2007.

## **FACTS**

1. On, September 24, 2011 at approximately 1:07 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Barber's Crossing North Incorporated.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Budlight bottle for three dollars and twenty-five cents (\$3.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. Administrative review of the files indicates no violations in over ten (10) years.

## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee had no violations in the past ten (10) years, the Commission issues a WARNING.
