Interpretation of "Systems"

Mass General Laws Chapter 141 Supervision of Electricians Section 1 Definitions

"Security System", an inherently power limited system of wires, conduits, apparatus, devices, fixtures, or other appliances installed and interconnected electrically or electronically to permit access control, proprietary signaling, surveillance and the detection of burglary, intrusion, holdup, or other conditions requiring response or the transmission of signals or audible alarms.

Mass General Laws Chapter 141 Supervision of Electricians Section 1A Licensure requirement; exceptions
Section 1A. No person, firm or corporation shall enter into, engage in, or work at the business or occupation of
installing wires, conduits, apparatus, devices, fixtures, or other appliances for carrying or using electricity for light,
heat, power, fire warning or security system purposes, unless such person, firm or corporation shall be licensed by the
state examiners of electricians in accordance with this chapter and, with respect to security systems, unless such
person, firm or corporation shall also be licensed by the commissioner of public safety in accordance with the
provisions of sections fifty-seven to sixty-one, inclusive, of chapter one hundred and forty-seven.

527 CMR References

Rule 1. All installations, repairs and maintenance of electrical wiring and electrical fixtures used for light, heat, power, signaling and communications purposes in buildings and structures subject to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 143 shall be reasonable safe to persons and property.

Rule 4. Where an actual hazard exists, the owner of the property shall be notified in writing by the authority enforcing this Code. The notification shall contain specifications of the actual hazard that exists, together with a reference to the rule of this Code that is now in violation. (See M.G.L. c. 166 Section 32 and 33, for enforcement authority.
