What is happening?

MassDOT is beginning Phase 1 of the full restoration of the Sumner Tunnel between East Boston and the North End. The project will begin in June 2022 and provide many public benefits including:

- Improved tunnel safety
- A smoother, more durable roadway surface
- New lighting and security systems
- Better cell phone, GPS, and radio service inside tunnel

All abutters and roadway users are invited to attend a virtual public information meeting to discuss the construction schedule, project impacts, and proposed detours that will begin in June 2022. A question and answer period will follow the presentation.
