PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 236 OF THE ACTS OF 2004

Dear Secretary Galvin:

In accordance with section 2A of Chapter 86 of the Acts of 2010, item 0521-0010, on April 29 and May 14, 2010 I certified to your office the amount of reimbursement to be distributed to 348 cities and towns that had submitted cost reports for the above-captioned election. Subsequently, the Towns of Carlisle and Charlemont have submitted certifiable data. Accordingly, I hereby certify the net amounts of reimbursement due as follows:

Charlemont	2,003	430	1,573

The Town of Carlisle reports that it did not incur Chapter 236 expenses in excess of the prior payment of \$2,244, mainly due to the availability of volunteers.

This supplemental certification brings the total amount certified for 350 cities and towns to \$7,869,773. December 2009 prior Uniform Polling Hours payments provided \$1,572,366 of this amount, with total net reimbursements to the 350 communities of \$6,297,407. Should the sole remaining community, the Town of Chester, report expenses to my office, I will forward the certification to you as soon as possible.
