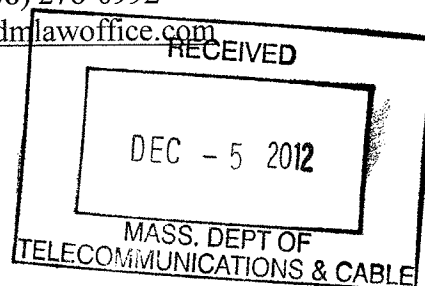

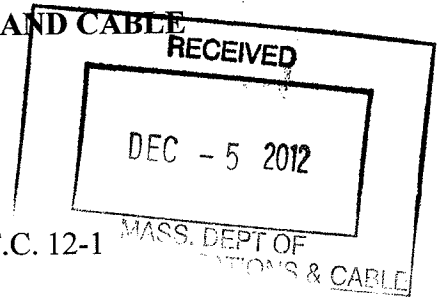

REQUEST D.T.C. 1-3: State whether there are any unresolved retransmission consent fee negotiations. If so, provide the status of those negotiations.

RESPONSE: Cox Communications' retransmission consent agreement with Meredith Corporation, owner of WSHM/CBS, expires 11/30/2012. Negotiations are underway and will continue as both parties work to reach an agreement by 11/30/2012 to avoid interruption of service to Cox customers. The Company will update this response if and when further information becomes available.
