

## **Supportive Housing**

The Supportive Housing Program combines housing with services for older adults and people living with disabilities.

Through this program, Resident Service Coordinators are on-site in subsidized housing to help residents access community resources, arrange meals, plan social activities, and manage issues that arise—helping to foster a sense of stability and community.



## **Eligibility & Cost**

Supportive Housing services are available to all residents that live in <u>Supportive Housing</u> <u>Sites</u>. Services are **free** and included in your rent/housing costs.

If you would like to live at a participating Supportive Housing Site, you can apply directly to the housing owner. Each housing site has its own eligibility requirements.
