

Supportive Housing

The Supportive Housing Program combines housing with services for older adults and people living with disabilities.

Through this program, Resident Service Coordinators are on-site in subsidized housing to help residents access community resources, arrange meals, plan social activities, and manage issues that arise—helping to foster a sense of stability and community.



Eligibility & Cost

Supportive Housing services are available to all residents that live in [Supportive Housing Sites](#). Services are **free** and included in your rent/housing costs.
