CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Susan Tringale, R.Ph. ("Registrant"), a pharmacist registered by the Board (Pharmacist Registration No. 16651), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Registrant which is maintained by the Board:


1. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") to resolve matters pending against the Registrant before the Board as Docket No. PH-08-002 (the "Complaint").
2. Registrant's acknowledges and agrees that the Complaint relates to the discipline of Registrant's pharmacist license (No. PR-5139) by the Maine Board of Pharmacy (Maine Board) pursuant to that certain *Decision and Order* in Re: Susan Tringale dated June 19, 2007. The Maine Board found Registrant had violated multiple state and federal statutes and regulations concerning her employment as a pharmacist at PIN Rx, LLC (Maine Charter No. 20052620DC) and various internet entities relating to its wholesale drug outlet operations. After consideration of Registrant's cooperation in its investigation, the Maine Board ordered Registrant's pharmacist license suspended for thirty days; reprimanded Registrant's pharmacist license; and issued a \$5,000.00 administrative fine (to be reduced if Registrant passes the MPJE by June 19, 2008).
3. Accordingly, the Registrant acknowledges and agrees to the following:
  - a. That her conduct as described in Paragraph 2 above warrants disciplinary action by the Board for conduct in violation of G.L. c. 112, s. 61 and 247 CMR 9.01(1), 9.01(2), 9.01(6), 9.01(11), 10.03(1)(a), 10.03(1)(b), 10.03(1)(e), 10.03(1)(k), 10.03(1)(l), 10.03(1)(t), 10.03(1)(u), 10.03(1)(v), and 10.03(1)(w);
  - b. That her pharmacist license is hereby **SUSPENDED** by the Board for the thirty (30) day period commencing as of the effective date of this Agreement;
  - c. That her pharmacist license is hereby **REPRIMANDED** by the Board; and
  - d. That she must take and pass the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE) with a score of at least 75% by June 19, 2008. Registrant shall provide official documentation of passing the MPJE to the Board not later than July 19, 2008.



4. The Agreement and its contents shall become a part of the records maintained by the Board, and as such, are public records subject to disclosure to the public, other licensing boards, and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.
5. In consideration of Registrant's execution of this Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the Registrant pursuant to the Complaint; any and all other rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved.
6. The Registrant understands and agrees that her failure to satisfy the terms of this Agreement shall constitute grounds for the Board to take additional disciplinary action regarding the License of the Registrant without the requirement for additional proceedings pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act (G.L. c. 30A) and 801 CMR 1.00 *et. seq.*
7. The Registrant understands and agrees that her decision to enter into this Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
8. The Registrant states that she has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Agreement or, if she did not, that she had an opportunity to do so and that her decision to enter into this Agreement was made of her own free will.
9. Registrant certifies that she has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement". The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, she is waiving her right to a formal hearing at which she would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on her own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in the State Administrative Procedure Act, G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.*


