## **DECISION**

**Re: Pleasant Valley Corporation**  
**Premise: 95 Armsby Road**  
**City/Town: Sutton, MA 01590**  
**License #: 125400001**  
**Heard: November 18, 2010**

Pleasant Valley Corporation (“the Licensee”) holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws c 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“the Commission”) held a hearing on October 14, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c 138, §64 – Failure to Comply with the Laws of the Commonwealth, to wit: M.G.L. c 151A §14 which resulted in an agreement between the licensee and the Department of Unemployment Assistance (“DUA”).

On November 18, 2010, a second hearing was held by the Commission as a result of the Licensee’s failure to meet the conditions of the payment plan it had agreed to. DUA requested revocation of the license.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Violation Report from Investigator Caroline Guarino-Wilichoski; and
2. Stipulation of Facts.

## **FACTS**

1. On October 14, 2010, the Commission held a hearing regarding alleged violations of M.G.L. c. 138, §64.
2. The Licensee appeared and stipulated to the facts in Investigator Guarino-Wilichoski’s report. Ex. 2
3. The Licensee was put on a payment plan and the matter was continued.

4. The Licensee did not file a license renew application for calendar year 2011. As such, the enforcement action is moot.
