**DECISION**

**RED SAUCE INC. D/B/A MEXICALI GRILL  
435 PARADISE STREET  
SWAMPSCOTT, MA 01907  
LICENSE#: 04131-RS-1256

Red Sauce Inc. d/b/a Mexicali Grill (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, September 23, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Kenny & Guarino’s Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigators Kenny and Guarino’s Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report;
  2. ABCC Application Summary Review, New License Approved 5/31/2018;
  3. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.
- A. Licensee Mexicali Swampscott Alcohol Serving Policy;  
B. (7) TIPS and ServSafe Certificates for Employees.

At the close of the hearing the Commission left the record open until Wednesday, September 24, 2025, for the Licensee to submit additional exhibits. The exhibits were received timely. The record is now closed.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Monday, June 2, 2025, at approximately 6:27 p.m., Investigators Guarino & Kenny (“Investigators”) conducted a compliance check at Red Sauce Inc. d/b/a Mexicali Grill.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, was delivered but did not pay for, an alcoholic beverage one Bud Light draft beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2018 with no previous violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
